The Koenig Family

1 *GERMANY*

Moessingen, Germany

Genealogical records, going back to at least the 1600s, indicate the generations of the Koenig family had all lived at Moessingen, Germany.

2 *SOUTH RUSSIA* (now UKRAINE)

Moessingen, Germany to Alexanderhelf, Russia

In the earlier part of the 1800s, Johannes Koenig and his wife Margarethe Lautenschlager were among the many people who migrated to the sparsely populated regions in South Russia and remained there for the rest of their lives. Johannes was born in 1795 at Moessingen, Germany, and Margarethe was born that same year at Kis-Ker, Hungry.

Alexanderhelf to Grossliebental to Rosenfeld Township, Russia

Johannes' son Johannes Koenig was born in 1820 at Alexanderhelf, Russia. His first wife, Christine Luithle died sometime after their second child was born. Johannes then married Karolina Widmaier about 1844. They lived at Grossliebental, Russia until the early 1860s, at which time they moved to Rosenfeld Township, Russia.

3 *UNITED STATES*

Rosenfeld Township, Russia to the United States

In 1889, a group of 25-30 Koenig family members immigrated together to the United States. Among those who came over together were Johannes and Karolina Koenig, their son Jacob Koenig and his wife Charlotte and their children. Johannes and Karolina Koenig are buried in the Berlin Baptist Church Cemetery about 15 miles NE of Ashley, McIntosh County, ND.

Jacob and Charlotte began their married life together in South Russia, now Ukraine

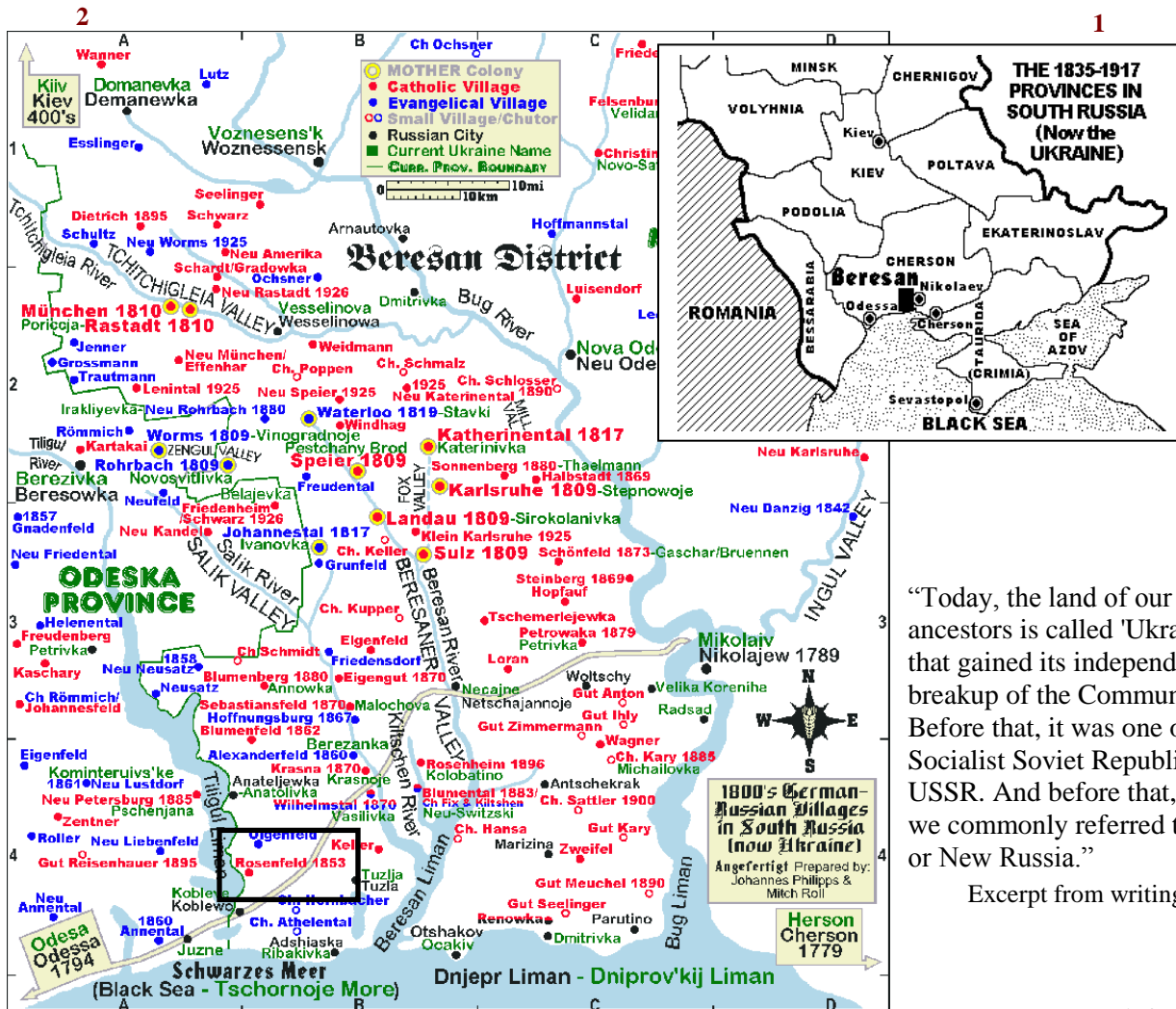


Jacob and Charlotte Koenig

Jacob Koenig (also spelled Jakob) was born January 14, 1850, at Aleksanderhlf, Odessa, South Russia, the 4th of 15 children to Johannes and Karolina (Widmaier) Koenig.

Charlotte Ackermann (other spelling Charlotta Akkermann) was born February 12, 1850 at Rohrbach, Beresan, South Russia, the daughter of Friederich and Barbara (Herman) Akkermann

In 1870, Jacob and Charlotte married and settled in Rosenfeld, Beresan, South Russia where eight of their eleven children were born: Jacob II in 1874, Katherine in 1876, Louisa in 1878, Caroline in 1882, Charlotte in 1884, Elizabeth in 1885, Amelia in 1887, and Christine in 1888.

Jacob and Charlotte Koenig

Moving to the United States

In 1889, Jacob and Charlotte, together with their eight children ranging in age from 1 to 15 years old, emigrated from Rosenfeld, South Russia to the United States on the ship Augusta Victoria. They were at first in Chicago, Illinois and then went to South Dakota. From there, they moved to Napoleon, Logan County, North Dakota where their daughter Lydia was born in 1893; then to Pony Gulch, Wells County, North Dakota where their daughter Barbara was born in 1896; and finally to Goodrich, Sheridan County, North Dakota where their daughter Emma was born in 1898. Jacob died in November of 1914 and Charlotte died January 28, 1916.

Jacob Koenig was born on March 6, 1874 at Rosenfeld, Beresan, South Russia to Jacob and Charlotte Koenig. In 1889 at age fifteen, Jacob emigrated from Russia to the United States with his parents and siblings.

Fredericka Hildenbrand (other spelling Fredricka) was born March 25, 1880 at Bordon, Beresan, South Russia to Jacob and Elizabeth (Miller) Hildenbrand. In 1889 at age nine, Fredericka emigrated from Russia to the United States with her parents and siblings John and Magdalena "Maggie" (Janz). Other children born to Jacob and Elizabeth Hildenbrand in America were: Mary born in the fall of 1898 soon after their arrival, Pauline in 1892, David in 1893 and Lydia (Lucas) in 1895.

On November 28, 1898, Jacob and Fredericka were married. They first lived at Goodrich, where Jacob was engaged in a machinery dealership. Born to them at Goodrich were: John in 1899, Emma in 1900, Lydia in 1901, William 1903, John in 1905 and Edward in 1907. That same year, they moved to Manfred Township. David was born at Manfred in 1909 and Esther in 1911. In 1912, Jacob and Fredericka purchased land from Mark E. Wilson and began farming where their remaining children were born: Jacob 'Jake' in 1914, Walter in 1916, Fred in 1918, and Adeline in 1920.

Jacob served as manager of the Manfred Livestock Shipping Association. During the depression years, cattle sold for \$15 a head, and hogs wouldn't even pay for the freight to St. Paul. Jacob was also a member of the elevator board at Manfred for many years. Family members recall that Jacob was gone a lot with his job of buying and selling cattle. Cattle would be loaded onto cattle railroad cars from the livestock yard at Manfred. Jacob traveled on that same freight train to Chicago where he then sold the cattle. With Jacob being away so much, his children did most of the farm work, as well as helping their mother Fredericka. It is remembered that Fredericka enjoyed crocheting.

In 1940, Jacob and Fredericka retired from their farming duties and moved to Lodi, CA. They had wintered at Lodi for a number of years before this. Jacob and Fredericka were active members of the Baptist churches of both Fessenden and Lodi. Jacob died February 28, 1943. In about 1961, Fredericka moved back to North Dakota. At first, she lived with relatives at Fessenden and later made her home at Haaland Home at Rugby and then the Home of the Good Shepherd in New Rockford where she died January 2, 1965. Jacob and Fredericka are buried at Cherkee Memorial Cemetery in Lodi, CA

Jacob and Fredericka's first child John Koenig was born September 5, 1899, but died December 27, 1899 when he was less than four months old.

Emma Koenig was born November 20, 1900 near Goodrich, ND, growing up near Manfred, ND and attended school there. Her father was a buyer of cattle and was gone from home a lot. With her father gone so much, Emma, the eldest, became like a second mother to her younger siblings. The children did most of the farm work and helping their mother. On July 6, 1923 at the First Baptist Church of Fessenden, ND, Emma married **John Leischner**, born September 9, 1894 in Parkston, SD. Emma and John settled in Canada, their children being born there and where they engaged in farming.

Later, John and Emma and family moved to Wells County. John was sick quite a lot, and passed away January 18, 1944 in Fessenden, ND. After John's passing, Emma continued living in Fessenden. She was a hard worker; some of her jobs included serving as janitor at the Nazarene Church and cooking and cleaning for the Eastern Star Nursing Home located in the Beiseker Mansion. In 1992, she moved to an assisted living home. Emma was 99 years old at the time of her passing on October 12, 1999 in Minot, ND.

John and Emma had four children:

- 1. Earl** married Clara Curtis and they had two children **1**Earl; and **2**William married Barbara Speedwell and they have a son William. Earl died in 2002.
- 2. Adeline** "Addy" married Milton "Mike" Guy and they have four children **1**Lynn married Ronald Rogelstad and they have two children **1**Erik and **2**Isaac; **2**Ray married (Rita) Clarice Linnertz and they had three children **1**MacAllan, **2**Mitchell married Molly Kvigne, and **3**Marshall; **3**Ronald married Pamela Mardian and they have three children **1**Daniel, **2**Michael, and **3**Steven; and **4**Mark married Sheila Lindquist. Sheila has a son Lyndon Coutts who married Alysia Engh, and Mark and Sheila have a daughter Shanda.

Lydia Koenig was born December 20, 1901 in Goodrich, ND, then grew up near Manfred and attended school there. On her birthday in 1925 at the First Baptist Church of Fessenden, ND, she married **William Schimke**, born September 27, 1901 in Harvey, ND. At first, they farmed south of Harvey. Later, they went to California, but just one year later William died of a cerebral hemorrhage on February 14, 1937. The family returned to North Dakota by train leaving everything behind, except for what could fit in their suitcases. At that same time, William's body was also brought back to North Dakota.

Lydia and her children lived with her brother Ed Koenig for a while, and then moved to the house where Oscar and Christine Ongstad had lived before they moved to the parsonage to care for Pastor Langseth. Lydia found work wherever she could including working in a cook car during harvest. With Lydia busy working, she taught her children how to garden and they also did all the canning. In 1942, the family settled in Fessenden where Lydia found work at the Connor Hotel. Lydia died of blood clots on May 19, 1947 in Harvey, ND two weeks after she had a surgery. William and Lydia are buried at the Congregational Church Cemetery south of Harvey. At the time of their mother's passing, Lillian was in her first year of teaching, Gordon was 16, and Ellorine was 12. Gordon went to live with Lydia's brother Ed and his wife Lorene who became like second parents to him. Lillian stayed with Ed and Lorene, too, as a young teacher.

William and Lydia had five children:

- 1. Lavern** married Hilbert Breckel and they have three children **1**Joan married David Fair and they had two children **1**Kristine has three children Talita, Joshua, and Natalie, and **2**Jennifer. Joan later married Richard Philips; **2**Allen married Mary Bucknam and they have a son Aaron; and **3**Darrell married Christine Thomas and they had three children **1**Leslie married Evan Schiebout and they have four children Ellie, Lana, Alyse, and Jacob, **2**Lindsey married Brady Starr and they have a daughter Finley, and **3**Carrie. After Christine died, Darrell married Margie Bocast.
- 2. Lillian** married Oscar Gedrose and they had five children **1**Donald married Lila Payne and they had three children **1**Dirk, **2**Melissa married Gavin Johanson and they have three children Alexis, Brooke, and Jace, and **3**Eric married Sarah Sager. Donald later married Betty Rouche; **2**Karen married Myron Runge and they have three children **1**Joel married Denise Wink and they have seven children Tanner, Aaron, Logan, Tate, Landon, Braylon, and Teagan, **2**Bruce married Meredith Fredin and they have three children Kade, Brooklyn, and Quinn, and **3**Heidi married Brian Johnson and they have one son Asher; **3**Susan married Richard Clonts and they have two children **1**Sherye married Gary Decker and they had a son Ethan. Sherye later married Bill Goebe, and **2**James; **4**Duane married Patrice Lura and five children were born to them **1**Shawn died in infancy, **2**Lindsay married Aaron Vogeler, **3**Michael, **4**Amy, and **5**Jordan; and **5**Orin married Colleen Klein and they had three children **1**Meredith married Don Featherston, **2**Allison married Emmanuel Asante, and **3**Jennifer married Dominick Yate. Oscar died in 2008.
- 3. Gordon** was born in Harvey and married Betty Larson in First Lutheran Church of Fessenden, ND. Three children were born to them **1**Tammy married Kevin Vetter and they have three children **1**Brandon married Robin Nehring and they have a son Andrew, **2**Shanna married Tom Ellingboe, and **3**Nicholas; **2**Karla died in 1970; and **3**Jodi married Rick Kuske. Jodi later married Kim Erfle and they have a son Austin.
- 4. Allen** died when he was nearly 14 years of age. It was thought at first that he had the flu, but instead his appendix had burst. Allen died 52 days later on February 11, 1946.
- 5. Ellorine** married Clifford Goebel and they had three children **1**Roxanne married Donald Gill and they have two children **1**Matthew married Sarah Ward, and **2**Chelsea married Christopher Roberts; **2**Michael married Lori Laeger and they have two children Lauren and McKenzie; and **3**Steven married Rachel Radanke and they have two children Mila and Max.

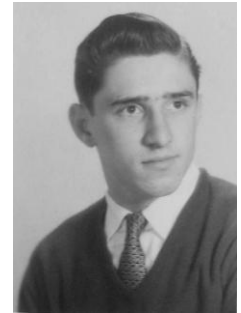
4. William Koenig

William “Bill” Koenig was born October 18, 1903 in Goodrich, ND, then grew up at Manfred and attended school there. William disliked farming, so he hopped a freight train and went to Chicago where he began working for International Harvester. He remained with this firm throughout his career, working his way up in the company. On June 10, 1925 in Chicago Heights, IL, he married **Grace Worn**, born February 27, 1906 in Crown Point, IN. They adopted a son **William A. “Billy” Koenig**.

After retiring, they moved to Florida. Bill died June 14, 1993 in Largo, FL and Grace died in Largo, FL on October 27, 1996. Their son Bill continues to live in Florida.

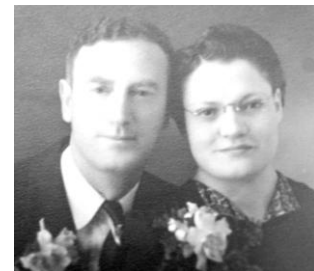
5. John Koenig

John Koenig was born November 21, 1905 in Goodrich, ND, then grew up near Manfred and attended school there. In 1919, John moved to Lodi, CA, where he operated a dairy for six years and then a grocery store for five years.

On March 19, 1939 in Reno, NV, he married **Selma Hintz**, born September 12, 1910 in Leighe, KS. In 1970, John retired from Allen Honey Products of Stockton, CA. John died January 19, 1971. Selma died about 1991.

John and Selma had two sons:

- 2. Floyd** married Gloria Dye and they have two children **1**James; and **2**Mark.



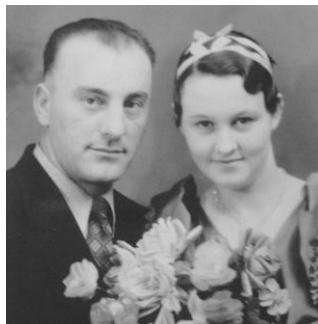

Fred farmed until May of 1941 when he was inducted into the United States Army. Upon discharge in September of 1945, Fred came back to the home farm at Manfred and continued farming.

On June 26, 1949, he was united in marriage to **Marlys Hagen** born April 4, 1928 in Hamberg, ND, daughter of Melvin and Jennie Hagen of Sheyenne, ND.
